Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 14, 2006, Connie Durcsak of PCIA – The Wireless Infrastructure Association, exchanged telephone messages with Joel Taubenblatt of the FCC’s Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (the “Bureau”). In a message to Mr. Taubenblatt, Ms. Durcsak confirmed that PCIA and CTIA – The Wireless Association (“CTIA”) met to discuss the details of their respective proposals for clearinghouse procedures and operations.

In the message, Ms. Durcsak also addressed CTIA’s request in its *ex parte* submission of December 7, 2006 that the Commission explicitly require AWS and MSS/ATC entities to file PCN data with both clearinghouses. PCIA disagrees with CTIA’s characterization of this request as a “minor, non-controversial item.” PCIA urges that at the time of each filing (whether link or PCN data) the filer be able to select which clearinghouse it will use. That choice would be made by submitting its data to only one clearinghouse.

Finally, Ms. Durcsak indicated that PCIA and CTIA are continuing to discuss clearinghouse operations. The parties are scheduled to discuss their respective proposals early next week, prior to a joint meeting among the parties and the Bureau staff.
