Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1.1206 of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC" or "Commission"), TerreStar submits this notification of *ex parte* communication between its staff and representatives of the FCC. In particular, on December 19, 2006, David LaFrance, Director of Regulatory Affairs of TerreStar and the undersigned counsel met with the following members of the FCC's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau staff: Eugenie N. We discussed the architecture of the anticipated TerreStar mobile satellite service ("MSS") system and how devices that include the TerreStar chipset may have the ability to roam on networks of other carriers.
