This letter discloses a permitted *ex parte* contact in the above-referenced docket. On December 19, 2006, undersigned counsel for Centennial Communications, accompanied by Mr. William Roughton, Centennial's Vice President, Legal & Regulatory Affairs, met with Mr. Barry Ohlson of Commissioner Adelstein's office. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss Centennial's filings in the above-referenced docket.

Centennial's representatives explained that, as set out in Centennial's filings, certain modest conditions should be placed on the pending transaction in order to offset the harms to competition likely to result from the sale of a domestic United States incumbent local exchange carrier to an entity that has no institutional knowledge of or experience with meeting the requirements placed on incumbent carriers by the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
