Today, AT&T Inc. (“AT&T”) and BellSouth Corporation (“BellSouth”; collectively, the “Applicants”) have filed (via the Universal Licensing System and the International Bureau Filing System) minor amendments to the applications previously filed in this merger proceeding.
