Inland Cellular Telephone Company ("Inland"), the general partner of Eastern Sub – RSA Limited Partnership and Washington RSA No. 8 Limited Partnership (collectively "the Partnerships"), hereby amends its November 17, 2006 Hearing Aid-Compatibility ("HAC") Status Report.¹ Inland is submitting this amendment in order to update the Commission on the current status of the Partnerships' efforts and progress toward compliance with the Commission's hearing aid-compatibility requirements and to ensure the completeness of its reports.

In the November 2006 Status Report, Inland reported that 7 of the 12 handset models it offers are according to their manufacturers, are HAC compliant. After filing the November 2006 Status Report, Inland learned of additional information concerning its handset offerings and determined that of the 7 HAC-compliant handsets reported in the November 2006 Status Report, 3 handsets meet the Commission's T4 rating as set forth in Section 20.19(d)(2) of the Commission's Rules.² The remaining 5 handsets meet at least the M3 rating. They are:

² As Inland has reported to the FCC before, due to the Partnerships' status as Tier III carriers, it cannot deal directly with handset manufacturers and must rely on third party vendors for its handsets as well as information concerning handsets. As a result, Inland was unaware when it filed its November 2006 Status Report that 3 models had been awarded a T4 rating.

Additionally, since the time the November 2006 Status Report was filed, Inland began offering an additional handset that meets the T4 rating (the Motorola L7c), thus bringing Inland's T4-rated handset offerings to 4. Inland calculates that approximately 61 percent of the models available to new subscribers are at least M3-rated, and approximately 31 percent of the models available to new subscribers are T4-rated.
