

SUPPLEMENT TO HEARING AID-COMPATIBILITY STATUS REPORT

North Carolina RSA 1 Partnership (“NCR1P”) hereby amends and supplements its November 17, 2006 Hearing Aid Compatibility (“HAC”) Status Report.¹ NCR1P is submitting this supplement in order to update the Commission on the current status of its efforts and progress towards compliance with the Commission’s HAC requirements and to ensure the completeness of its reports.

In its November 2006 Status Report, NCR1P reported that it offered a total of 4 handset models for sale, and that 3 of those handset models were HAC-compliant. NCR1P has since determined that its HAC-compliance is more extensive than previously thought. As of the date of the instant filing, NCR1P offers a total of 8 handsets: 2 T4-rated handsets² and 6 M3-rated handsets. They are:

NCR1P calculates that 100 percent of the models available to new subscribers are at least M3-rated, and approximately 25 percent of the models available to new subscribers are T4-rated.
