Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 4, 2007, the undersigned, on behalf of the AdHoc Telecommunications Users Committee (“AdHoc” or “Committee”), had telephone conversations with Scott Deutchman, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Copps regarding the proceeding captioned above. Specifically, Ad Hoc expressed its support for the voluntary, enforceable commitments regarding special access services which AT&T described in its December 28, 2006 *ex parte* letter and which were reprinted as an attachment to the Commission’s December 29, 2006 press release. Because those commitments were accepted in a final order adopted by the full Commission, implementation of those commitments by the applicants is necessary for AT&T to be in compliance with the Commission’s order. Ad Hoc urged the Commission to ensure that the applicants implement those commitments and observed that the final order applies to the actions of the Commission or its subdivisions until such time as the Commission reconsiders or rescinds the order in a subsequent order.
