Re: Application for Consent to the Transfer of Control of Telecomunicaciones de Puerto Rico, Inc. from Verizon to América Móvil (WT Docket. No. 06-113)

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of América Móvil, S.A. de C.V. (“América Móvil”), this letter updates the record of the above-referenced proceeding with regard to certain transactions involving Verizon and América Móvil that were signed concurrently with the instant transaction. Specifically, as Verizon and América Móvil have explained in previous filings, América Móvil is also acquiring Verizon’s ownership interests in Verizon Dominicana, in the Dominican Republic.¹ América Móvil hereby reports that the acquisition of Verizon Dominicana was consummated on December 1, 2006.

América Móvil, in conjunction with its sister corporation Teléfonos de México, S.A. de C.V., is also acquiring Verizon’s ownership interests in CANTV, in Venezuela, though, as of the date of this letter, that transaction has not been consummated. As the parties noted in the Application, “[i]f all three transactions are consummated, PRT LD will retain its current foreign carrier affiliation with CANTV and Verizon Dominicana, and will continue to comply with the dominant foreign carrier affiliation safeguards in the FCC’s rules.” *Id.*
