Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 9, 2007, Glenn Britt, President and CEO of Time Warner Cable ("TWC"), met with FCC Chairman Kevin Martin and Catherine Bohigian, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis. During this meeting, Mr. Britt discussed the petitions filed by TWC in WC Dockets Nos. 06-54 and 06-55. Consistent with the points made in prior written submissions, Mr. Britt emphasized that Time Warner Cable is eager to offer its facilities-based Digital Phone service to urban and rural consumers alike, but several state commissions have issued rulings at the behest of rural LECs that have made it impossible for TWC to enter certain rural areas. Mr. Britt urged the Commission to act expeditiously in granting the pending petitions to address the anticompetitive actions that have prevented TWC from bringing the benefits of facilities-based competition to tens of thousands of rural consumers.

In addition, with respect to the Commission's recent adoption of a Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking implementing general franchising requirements pursuant to Section 621(a) of the Communications Act, Mr. Britt stressed the importance of a level playing field, and urged the Commission to ensure that any findings from the Report and Order applicable to new entrants also be applied to existing franchisees as quickly as possible.

Finally, consistent with TWC's prior written submission, Mr. Britt expressed his support for the Petition filed by NCTA (CSR-7056-Z) seeking a temporary waiver of the integration ban until the deployment of downloadable security or December 31, 2009, whichever is earlier.
