Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of KRTV Communications, Inc. ("KRTV"), permittee of KRTV-DT, Great Falls, Montana, we hereby supplement the FCC Form 381 which was filed electronically on November 4, 2004 and clarify the certification made by KRTV. A copy of the filed Form 381 is enclosed.

On April 9, 2003, the FCC granted a DTV channel change for KRTV-DT and substituted DTV channel 7 for KRTV(TV)'s assigned DTV channel 44. Unlike the channel 44 allotment, the channel 7 allotment parameters provides for facilities that exceed the replicated analog service area for the station.

In response to Question 1 on the FCC Form 381, KRTV selected certification "c," which states: "Licensee/permittee hereby certifies that it will operate its post-transition DTV station based on its allotted replication facilities." By this letter, KRTV clarifies this certification to advise the FCC that KRTV intends to construct digital facilities that will replicate the station's analog service area rather than facilities that reflect the station's allotment, as modified. KRTV believes the chosen certification most closely matches its intended certification.
