On Friday, January 26, 2007, Anna Miller, Sara Leibman, and Amy Wolverton of T-Mobile, U.S.A., Inc. met with John Adams, Jennifer Schneider, and Ann Stevens of the Wireline Competition Bureau. During this meeting, representatives of T-Mobile discussed their Petition for Declaratory Ruling requesting that all carriers obligated to provide number portability may not obstruct or delay the porting process by demanding from the porting-in carrier information in excess of the minimum information needed to validate the requesting customer. Participants emphasized how simple number porting rules and processes would maximize consumer choice and foster industry competition, as more specifically outlined in the attached presentation document.
