Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, Iowa Telecommunications Service, Inc. ("Iowa Telecom") hereby submits this letter summarizing an ex parte presentation made yesterday, September 25, 2006 in the above-referenced Docket.

On January 30, 2007, Greg Vogt, of the Law Offices of Gregory J. Vogt, PLLC, and I, counsel to Iowa Telecom, met with Jeremy Marcus, Vicki Robinson, Katie King, and Ted Burmeister of the Telecommunications Access Policy Division of the Wireline Competition Bureau to discuss the above-referenced matter.

The meeting addressed Iowa Telecom's petitions for forbearance from or waiver of the universal service high-cost loop mechanisms. The meeting summarized the positions Iowa Telecom has taken in this docket. It emphasized that the impact on the fund would be minimal and the general assumptions Iowa Telecom made in estimating the impact on the universal service fund.
