
DECLARATION OF JON KENNEKE

I, JON KENNEKE, state and declare under penalty of perjury that the following is a true and correct statement of fact.

1. I am the Chief Engineer for Stations KHPE(FM)/KWIL(AM), Albany, Oregon, which is licensed to Extra Mile Media, Inc. I have held this position since November of 2000.
2. Station KHPE(FM) operates on a frequency of 107.9 MHZ with an effective radiated power of 100 kilowatts. The station operates with a Harris HT-25K transmitter which was installed at our transmitter site in 2001.
3. In late January - early February, 2004, I received a call from the local FCC field office stating that the FAA had determined there was an intermod problem caused in significant part by the signal of Station KHPE(FM) in conjunction with the signal of Station KLOO(FM), Corvallis, Oregon. (Station KLOO(FM) operates on 106.3 MHz). Our station retained a consulting engineer who immediately looked into the matter and confirmed that in fact there was an intermod problem effecting the localizer frequency (109.5 MHz) used at the airport in Eugene, Oregon. The Eugene Airport is approximately 33 miles from the KHPE(FM) transmitter site. The approach flight path to the Eugene Airport passes almost directly the KHPE tower.
4. After confirming the intermod problem we were advised by our consultant engineer to install a notch filter. We ordered the filter and installed it in late March/April, 2004. Immediately thereafter we had measurements conducted by our consulting engineer who confirmed that the objectionable interference caused by the intermod problem had been eliminated. The FAA and the FCC were notified of this corrective action and since that time we have had no complaints about intermod problems affecting aeronautical frequencies as a result of KHPE(FM)'s operation on 107.9 MHz.

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
