On Monday, February 5, 2007, Don Brittingham representing Verizon Wireless, Mike Senkowski of Wiley Rein LLP, and the undersigned met with the Commission staff to discuss the company's positions in the above-captioned proceedings. Present at the meeting were Fred Campbell of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Julius Knapp and Ron Chase of the Office of Engineering and Technology.

Consistent with previous discussions with the Commission, Verizon Wireless reiterated its belief that all 700 MHz rule making efforts should be completed expeditiously to ensure that the auction for this spectrum is held in accordance with statutory requirements. Verizon Wireless also repeated its concerns raised in previous filings in the above-referenced dockets.
