On Wednesday, February 7, 2007, Kathleen Ham, Sara Leibman and Patrick Welsh of T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile") and Doane Kiechel, counsel for T-Mobile, spoke by telephone with Paul Murray and Paul D'Ari of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, to discuss the pending Petition for Reconsideration or, in the Alternative, Clarification of T-Mobile USA, Inc. filed in the this docket on January 27, 2005. T-Mobile reiterated the concerns about certain language in the Second Report and Order, Order on Reconsideration and Second Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, 19 FCC Rcd 17503 (2004), requiring that an applicant obtain a supplemental ruling on foreign ownership, depending upon the type of service and geographic coverage area encompassed by a prior ruling, as further detailed in the Petition.
