Yesterday, Mr. Ed Shakin, Ms. Leslie Owsley, Mr. Kevin Green and I met with Mr. Tom Navin, Ms. Renee Crittendon and Mr. Marcus Maher of the Wireline Competition Bureau. We emphasized that since the initiation of the proceeding (WC Docket No. 02-112) that addresses what, if any, requirements should be imposed in a post 272 Sunset environment there have been significant developments in the communication industry. These include the fast growing competition for voice services and the deployment of advanced broadband networks which are increasingly agnostic with regard to geography. We urged the staff to incorporate these developments in their analysis of the issues raised in the above proceedings.
