PETITION FOR RULEMAKING

CCR-Lamar IV, LLC ("CCR"), the licensee of broadcast station KLMR-FM, Lamar, Colorado, hereby submits this Petition for Rulemaking to request that the Commission institute a proceeding to amend Section 73.202(b) of its rules, the FM Table of Allotments, to specify a new channel for the current, vacant allocation at Arriba, Colorado. The attached Engineering Statement demonstrates that this Petition is in full accord with Commission's rules and policies.

CCR proposes that the current, vacant allocation at Arriba, Colorado be changed from Channel 240A to Channel 287A, with no other changes to the allotment facilities. Grant of this requested channel change would result in a preferential arrangement of allotments as provided in the Commission's change of community procedures because the requested channel change at Arriba will permit a corresponding change of the channel specified for the current, vacant allotment at Hugo, Colorado from Channel 222A to 240A, which will permit a corresponding channel change for the facilities of broadcast station DKIIQ, Limon, Colorado from Channel 229A, Limon to Channel 222A, Limon, which, in turn, will facilitate CCR's proposed community and channel changes for station KLMR-FM from Lamar to Deer Trail, Colorado.

In an application submitted simultaneously herewith, CCR proposes to change KLMR-FM's facilities from Channel 228C1, Lamar, Colorado to Channel 229C1, Deer Trail, Colorado.

CCR's proposed change to KLMR-FM's facilities will provide a first local transmission service to Deer Trail, Colorado while leaving Lamar with two transmission services – one AM and one FM. (CCR's full Section 307(b) statement with respect to the proposed changes to KLMR-FM's facilities is included with its application on Form 301.) In order to effectuate its proposed change to KLMR-FM, CCR must submit the instant petition to permit the associated channel change to the Hugo, Colorado allocation (the "Hugo Petition"). Grant of this petition will permit a grant of the Hugo Petition, which will ultimately permit the Commission to grant CCR's proposed minor modification of KLMR-FM.

Grant of the instant petition will have no affect on the Arriba allotment community, coverage area or population served because CCR proposes no changes to the current allotment's community, coordinates or class of station.

The following is a summary of the changes to the FM table of allotments, Section 73.202(b)(1), proposed herein:

Nov. 29, 2006), 39 C.R. 1218 (the "FM Revision Order"), CCR hereby requests that the Commission cross-reference this petition with the Hugo Petition and CCR's application for modification of KLMR-FM's facilities as specified in File BPH-20070119_____.

SUMMARY

The following engineering statement has been prepared on behalf of CCR-LAMAR IV, LLC ("CCR"), licensee of KLMR-FM Lamar, Colorado and applicant for a minor change in community of license which relies upon the instant Petition for Rulemaking ("PRM") to move KLMR-FM from Lamar, Colorado to Deer Trail, Colorado providing that community with a first local service.

CCR's proposed changes, including its proposed changes to the Table of Allotments, are summarized as follows:

In this petition for rulemaking, CCR proposes to amend the Table of Allotments as follows:

ALLOCATION

This petition is based on the Commission's Rules which allow for amendments to the Table of Allotments where the amended allotment would be required to achieve a minor change in community of license. In this case, the proposed allotment for Channel 229C1 at Deer Trail, Colorado is short spaced to the

allotment coordinates for Channel 229A at Limon, Colorado as shown in the KLMR-FM 301 application. A 301 application is being filed to move DKIIQ Channel 229A to Channel 222A, necessitating modification to the Table of Allotments for Hugo and Arriba, Colorado as described herein.

Table 1 is an allocation study demonstrating that Channel 287A can be allocated to Arriba, Colorado without any additional changes to the Table of Allotments for Arriba, Colorado. The proposed allotment coordinates and city reference coordinates are essentially the same, as seen below, and are unchanged from the current Channel 240A allotment:

COMMUNITY DATA

No change in community is proposed.

COVERAGE AREA

No change in allotment site or class is proposed and thus no change in coverage.

GAINS AND LOSSES

Since there is no change in allotment site or class, there are no gains and losses.

CONCLUSION

The proposed deletion of Channel 240A at Arriba, Colorado and the proposed substitution of Channel 287A is believed to comply with all applicable FCC allocation Rules and Policies and will result in no change in the Arriba allotment characteristics while allowing significant public interest gains associated with the proposed KLMR-FM community of license change.
