On Wednesday, February 7, 2007, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Paul Garnett, Assistant Vice President, and Brian Josef, Director, CTIA – The Wireless Association® met with Fred Campbell, Chief of the FCC's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau to discuss proceedings necessary to facilitate the 700 MHz transition. During the meeting, CTIA representatives and Mr. Campbell discussed the Commission's ongoing efforts to ensure the CMRS industry has access to the spectrum it needs to continue to innovate and serve its more than 230 million mobile wireless customers. CTIA also expressed its desire to see the Commission move toward a swift resolution of these issues to meet the statutory deadlines in the DTV Transition statute.
