TELEVISION STATION SECTION 339(a)(2)(D)(vii) WAIVER REQUEST

Dear Ms. Dortch:

MMM License II LLC (FRN: 0011094281) (“MMM”), the licensee of television broadcasting station KFBB-DT (“KFBB”), Great Falls, Montana, by its attorney, hereby requests a waiver of the digital signal testing requirement,¹ in accordance with the statutory criteria set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 339(a)(2)(D)(viii), and pursuant to the procedures set forth in FCC Public Notice DA 05-2979, released November 17, 2005. KFBB is entitled to a waiver because approval of its DTV modification application was delayed extensively due to the need for international coordination.²

MMM filed a DTV modification application (the “Application”) for KFBB on July 7, 2007, specifying its full replication facility. On September 22, 2006, the FCC informed MMM’s counsel that the Application could not be granted until Canadian clearance was obtained. The Application was granted on February 8, 2007, and expires on August 8, 2007.³ KFBB’s digital signal coverage will be limited beyond the implementation of the digital signal testing requirement as a result of the lengthy delay in obtaining Canadian clearance.

² Waiver is appropriate pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 339(a)(2)(D)(viii)(I). Alternatively, waiver is also appropriate pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 339(a)(2)(D)(viii)(I) (force majeure).

³ On or about November 7, 2006, MMM’s counsel received a phone call from the FCC requesting KFBB’s antenna structure registration number, which counsel promptly supplied. No other requests for information were received while the Application was pending.



To the extent that the grant of the Application was delayed for reasons other than Canadian clearance, KFBB is entitled to a waiver of the digital signal testing requirement based on force majeure.⁴ KFBB supplied all information requested by the FCC in a timely fashion. The extensive delay in approving the Application was beyond MMM's control, and will limit KFBB's digital signal coverage.

For the reasons set forth above, and pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 339(a)(2)(D)(viii)(I), and, alternatively, 47 U.S.C. § 339(a)(2)(D)(viii)(III), MMM respectfully requests a six-month waiver of the digital signal testing requirement.
