ERRATUM

On January 25, 2007, AT&T Inc., on behalf of its affiliates ("AT&T"), filed the above-referenced Petition for Forbearance ("AT&T Petition").¹ On February 9, 2007, AT&T, on behalf of recently acquired BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), withdrew and resubmitted a similar petition (the "BellSouth Petition") that BellSouth had previously filed, and for which proceedings had taken place in WC Docket No. 05-342.² On February 16, 2007, the Commission issued a notice establishing a pleading cycle for the AT&T Petition, in which the Commission "synchroniz[e] the



comment cycles for the AT&T Petition and the resubmitted BellSouth Petition, and incorporate[d] the record from WC Docket No. 05-342 into WC Docket No. 07-21.”³

Upon review, AT&T discovered that the caption of the AT&T Petition, which indicates that the forbearance relief sought is “under 47 U.S.C. § 160,” contains a typographical error. The correct caption reference should be to “§ 160 (c).” Although the body of the petitions makes clear that relief is sought under section 160 (c), for avoidance of doubt, AT&T requests that the Commission accept this erratum with the corrected caption pages for the AT&T and BellSouth petitions.
