Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to a request by Federal Communications Commission (FCC or Commission) staff, and on behalf of Mid-Tex Cellular, Ltd. (Mid-Tex), this letter provides FCC Identification Numbers (FCC IDs) of certain phones identified by Mid-Tex in its Hearing Aid-Compatible (HAC) reports, request for waiver, and motion to withdraw.¹ Also pursuant to FCC request, this letter clarifies the information included in Mid-Tex's November 2006 compliance report.

Mid-Tex Cellular, Ltd.

The FCC has requested that Mid-Tex identify the FCC IDs for the following phones: Motorola V3, Motorola V220, Nokia 6102(h), Nokia 6103, and Nokia 6126. The FCC IDs are as are follows:

Mid-Tex filed its Petition for Limited Waiver (Petition) on July 25, 2006. The Petition sought relief from the FCC's requirement that Mid-Tex offer in the GSM portion of its network at least two handsets meeting a U3 or higher interference rating. On August 30, 2006, Mid-Tex filed a Motion to Withdraw its Petition because Mid-Tex was in full compliance with the FCC's HAC requirements. At the time Mid-Tex filed its Petition, it could not confirm the availability of any handsets that met the FCC's U3 HAC requirement. However, after filing its Petition, Mid-Tex learned that on June 15, 2005 the FCC certified the Nokia 6102(h) as GSM HAC compliant and that on October 10, 2005 the FCC certified the Nokia 6061 as GSM HAC compliant. Mid-Tex offered both handsets for sale beginning on April 10, 2006. Accordingly, Mid-Tex was in full compliance with the FCC's U3 HAC rule on April 10, 2006 and a waiver was therefore unnecessary.

Also pursuant to your request, Mid-Tex clarifies the information included in Mid-Tex's November 2006 compliance report. That report inadvertently failed to include the Nokia 6102(h) and the Nokia 6061 handsets. Mid-Tex is still selling both handsets.
