On February 16, 2007, I met with Bruce Gottlieb of the Office of Commissioner Michael Copps. During the meeting, we discussed the recent developments concerning M2Z's license application to provide National Broadband Radio Service in the 2155-2175. I noted the upcoming deadline for initial responses to the public notice regarding M2Z's application. We also discussed the need to establish a pleading cycle for M2Z's forbearance petition. In addition, I explained that M2Z has commissioned independent economic studies demonstrating the consumer welfare benefits resulting from M2Z's entry into the market under its proposed license terms.
