On February 26, 2007, Michal Fandel of the LoJack Corporation ("LoJack"), Laura Stefani and the undersigned, counsel for LoJack, and Amy Mehlman, consultant to LoJack, met with Dana Shaffer, Michael J. Wilhelm, Jeff Cohen and Tom Eng of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau, and Bruce Romano of the Office of Engineering and Technology, to discuss the above-referenced matter.

The need for the specific rule changes and the effect of allowing nationwide activation of LoJack mobile units was discussed. The substance of these positions is set out in LoJack's filings in the above-referenced proceeding. Additionally, Ms. Mehlman updated the staff on legislative activity concerning the tracking of hazardous materials.
