In accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the FCC's rules, this letter serves as notice that, on February 27, 2007, Everett R. Dobson, Chairman of the Board of Dobson Communications Corporation ("DCC"), and I met separately with the following Commissioners and staff members concerning issues in the above-referenced proceeding:

Chairman Kevin J. Martin and Fred Campbell
Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein and Barry Ohlson
Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate and Aaron Goldberger

Consistent with comments filed by DCC in this proceeding, in each of these meetings, Mr. Dobson and I suggested that, in order to promote the deployment of broadband services in rural America over the commercial 700 MHz spectrum, the Commission should adopt a band plan for this spectrum that includes blocks licensed in smaller service areas, and noted DCC's support for the "Balanced Consensus" band plan proposal. We also urged the Commission to schedule the auction of licenses for this spectrum so that prospective bidders have sufficient time (*i.e.*, at least six months after the adoption of service rules) to develop business plans and to raise capital to participate in the auction.
