Re: Application for Consent to the Transfer of Control of Telecomunicaciones de Puerto Rico, Inc. from Verizon to América Móvil, WT Docket. No. 06-113

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 1, 2007, Michael G. Jones, on behalf of América Móvil, S.A.B. de C.V., and Leslie V. Owsley and Donna Epps on behalf of VERIZON, spoke by telephone with Barry Ohlson, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Adelstein.

We provided additional information concerning four commitments that GTE made when it bought an interest in Telecomunicaciones de Puerto Rico, Inc. ("TELPRI") in 1999. GTE met the commitments. Specifically:

- GTE stated that Puerto Rico Telephone Company, Inc. ("PRT") would invest \$1 billion in facilities and services over five years. PRT's capital expenditure for the calendar years 2000 – 2004 was slightly over \$1 billion.
- GTE committed that PRT would not increase tariff rates for basic residential services for three years following the closing. GTE met that commitment and, in fact, there have been no tariff rate increases for basic residential services to date.
- GTE committed that PRT would provide internet access to non-profit secondary and post-secondary educational institutions at a 35 percent discount for five years after closing. In 1999, PRT offered dial-up internet access to schools for \$12 per month compared to the regular price of \$18.95 per month. While there are still a number of customers for this service, most schools are taking advantage of the Federal Schools and Libraries program, which effectively provides a greater discount.
- GTE committed that PRT would not involuntarily terminate any individuals employed at PRT as of May 27, 1998, except for cause. GTE met this commitment.
