On Monday, March 5, 2007, John Scott of Verizon Wireless and Mike Senkowski of Wiley Rein LLP met with Fred Campbell, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, to discuss Verizon Wireless's positions in the above-captioned proceedings.

Verizon Wireless discussed service rules for the 700 MHz licensees, including proposals for build out requirements based on population, and issues associated with combinatorial bidding.

With respect to the analog sunset proceeding, Verizon Wireless answered questions concerning the availability of higher power digital mobile phones for use in rural areas.
