TIA'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

The Telecommunications Industry Association (TIA), pursuant to Section 1.46(b) of the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC" or "Commission") rules, hereby submits a request for a 30-day extension of the deadline for filing comments in response to the above-captioned Petition, as well as a corresponding 30-day extension of deadline to file reply comments. Pursuant to this request, comments would be due April 30, 2007, and reply comments would be due May 15, 2007.

In addition to the reasons set forth in a joint motion filed by CTIA and Skype,¹ TIA believes this petition and the issues that may or may not be addressed therein will have a significant impact on the information, communications and entertainment technology industry, as a whole. Additional time would allow all interested parties to
