On March 7, 2007, representatives from the Dispatch Printing Company and Dispatch Broadcasting Group Michael F. Curtin, Vice Chairman, Associate Publisher and COO of the Dispatch Printing Company; Michael J. Fiorile, President, Dispatch Printing Company and CEO of Dispatch Broadcasting Group; Thomas C. Griesdorn, President and General Manager of WBNS-TV and Ohio News Network; Richard Pegram III, General Manager, VideoIndiana/WTHR-TV and VideoOhio/WALV-CA, and David L. Van Stone, President and General Manager of RadioOhio WBNS-AM and FM (along with Dispatch's counsel Jon Blake and Enrique Armijo of Covington and Burling LLP) met with Commissioner McDowell and his Legal Advisor Cristina Chou Pauzé.
