Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 8, 2007, the undersigned (“Ms. Desai”), of Media Access Project, and Pete Tridish (“Mr. Tridish”) of Prometheus Radio Project, met with Cristina Chou Pauzé, Legal Advisor, Media Issues, to Commissioner Robert M. McDowell. At this meeting, the parties discussed some of the issues raised in the LPFM proceeding.

Mr. Tridish discussed the preclusive effect of translators on LPFMs. He suggested that LPFMs should be given primary status over distant translators and reiterated Prometheus’ suggested standards for determining primary status as found in Prometheus’ previous filings in this proceeding. The parties also discussed the effect of the third adjacent restriction on LPFM opportunities.
