
in the above-captioned proceedings, and in support thereof states that while CEA referred to these requests in its Comments on the RCN² waiver request, the large number of such filings spread over more than one docket led to a misunderstanding as to comment dates. However, as CEA's comments disclose, CEA has addressed the arguments of these petitioners in previous Comments, and expects to address similar arguments in response to additional waiver requests to which responses are not yet due. Out of fairness to these particular petitioners, CEA includes in its motion a request for a coextensive extension of time for them to file Reply Comments, and has also served its Comments on those who commented in support of the waiver requests that are the subject of this motion. All parties are also being provided copies of the motion and the relevant Comments by email.

The CEA, therefore, respectfully requests that the Commission accept its Late Filed Comments in the above referenced matter and that the Commission grant an extension of time until March 21 for the petitioners to file Reply Comments in the above-captioned matter.
