

Dear Secretary Dortch,

Using the internet has become an important teaching tool for families and educators, and broadband access provides even more tools and information. I'm concerned that, for many, broadband access is not an option. Less than half of the students who live in households that make less than \$20,000 use the internet.

There is a solution being proposed to the FCC by M2Z Networks that would bring broadband access to all Americans. If approved, it would be easier for families to access on-line learning resources, and parents can be more involved in their child's education. Also, educators would have more access and less expense in finding teaching tools on-line.

Free, fast, and safe broadband access is needed. America cannot afford to fall behind technologically to many countries where broadband is already widely available.
