Dear Ms. Dortch:

PCIA – The Wireless Infrastructure Association (“PCIA”) and CTIA – The Wireless Association (“CTIA”) jointly file this notice pursuant to the Order of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (“Bureau”) in the above-referenced dockets adopted on March 8, 2007.¹ In the Order, the Bureau directs PCIA and CTIA, within ten calendar days of the release of the Order, to establish the exact technical format of the required data exchange and to report jointly to the Bureau that such an agreement has been reached.²

PCIA and CTIA have reached agreement on the data elements and the format for the data to be exchanged. PCIA and CTIA are continuing to explore the feasibility and efficiency of different data transfer methods; however, both agree that the clearinghouses are prepared to exchange data when the Order becomes effective.
