Dear Ms. Dortch:

I, Leonard R. Kahn, am writing to complain that Clear Channel Communications, Inc. has and is violating the Sherman Antitrust laws and is, indeed boycotting systems I have invented and for which I own various forms of intellectual property.

Please note that in official filings by the iBiquity Digital Corporation, the firm that claims to hold Patents that control the so called IBOC AM and FM broadcasting systems has named my Cam-D™ AM System as its (sole) IBOC competitor. It should be noted that the Cam-D system is on the air in a number of major cities, but not in the five biggest markets where the boycott has been totally effective. The Cam-D stations, have made measurements that prove that our system satisfies all FCC Rules. Therefore the Cam-D system is legal, whereas the FCC favored IBOC system would require changes in the law and therefore is obviously illegal.

Thus, I respectfully urge the Commission to immediately consider this matter as a number of these Clear Channel stations are waiting for FCC approval to transfer their licenses to publicly traded entities that may well create severe loss to the Public and may violate the controlling case, *RKO General Inc. v. FCC*, 670 F.2d 215.

Finally, during this time of national emergency, the IBOC system endangers this basic national resource for alerting the Public of natural and manmade disasters.
