Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is to report permitted, oral *ex parte* communications of Frontline Wireless, LLC (“Frontline”) and its counsel concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

On March 21, 2007, Janice Obuchowski (Chairman), Haynes Griffin (CEO), Stagg Newman (CTO) of Frontline Wireless, LLC and Jon Blake, its counsel, met with Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate and her legal advisor, Aaron Goldberger. In the meeting, the parties discussed Frontline’s Public Safety Deployment Plan and service rules that would allow the FCC to implement this Plan by relying on existing Commission authority and without delaying the 700 MHz spectrum auction. Mr. Blake also spoke by telephone with Cathy Massey and Jim Schlichting, Deputy Chiefs of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. During this conversation, the parties discussed the aforementioned service rules. Finally, Gerry Waldron, counsel to Frontline, communicated by telephone with Dana Shaffer, Deputy Bureau Chief of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau, and informed her about the need for coordinated treatment of the public safety *Ninth NPRM* and the service rules for the 700 MHz spectrum auction. Mr. Waldron also discussed Frontline’s commitment to address the issues that have been raised by the public safety community in response to the *Ninth NPRM*.
