SUBJECT: Motion to Dismiss RM-11306, ex-Parte filing of 14 Feb, and Erratum filing on 22 March 2007

To whom it may concern:

I previously filed comments in opposition to RM-11306, including the ex-Parte filing of 14 February 2007, and the Erratum filed on 22 March 2007. After reading the overwhelming opposition from the Amateur Operator Community as a whole, as well as from a large portion of the ARRL membership, I now move to dismiss the ARRL's RM-11306 petition and subsequent filings on the basis that the original RM-11306 has been substantially altered by the ARRL ex-Parte and Erratum filings. It should also be noted that the public has not been given any opportunity to officially comment on these changes within an approved period as required by the Commission's procedures for public review. The original content within RM-11306 has been altered by the ARRL's ex-Parte and recent Erratum filing such that it no longer represents the intent of the original document. Therefore I motion that RM-11306, the ex-Parte and the recent Erratum should be dismissed. This dismissal should be accompanied by a request/ruling that a separate and more accurate petition should be filed in their place. This would allow for proper review and due process of public opinion.
