On March 28, 2007, Dixie Ziegler, the Vice President of Hamilton Relay, Inc. ("Hamilton"), Anne Girard of Hamilton's Marketing and Regulatory Management group, and the undersigned on behalf of Hamilton, met with Ian Dillner and Nick Alexander of Chairman Kevin Martin's office.
