Dear Ms. Dortch:

KBYM-KMCMY, LLC, permittee of digital television (“DTV”) station KBYM-DT, Bismarck, North Dakota (Facility ID No. 22121), hereby notifies the Commission that KBYM-DT has completed its DTV buildout.

Station KBYM operates on NTSC channel 17 and DTV channel 16, and has received a tentative DTV channel designation on Channel 16. On June 29, 2006,<sup>1</sup> KBYM-KMCMY, LLC advised the Commission that it had filed an application (the “Modification Application”)<sup>2</sup> to modify the technical parameters of KBYM-DT’s then-current construction permit<sup>3</sup> to match the parameters with which the station was operating pursuant to special temporary authority (“STA”).<sup>4</sup> KBYM-KMCMY, LLC stated that, upon grant of the Modification Application, it would promptly file an application for a license to cover. Further, in order to continue service to the public, KBYM-KMCMY, LLC requested extension of the KBYM-DT’s reduced-power digital STA (the “STA Extension Request”).<sup>5</sup>

The Commission granted the Modification Application on March 6, 2007,<sup>6</sup> and KBMY-KMCY, LLC has filed a covering license application.<sup>7</sup> Accordingly KBMY-DT's buildout is now complete. KBMY-KMCY, LLC respectfully requests that the Commission continue to afford interference protection to the facilities specified in KBMY-DT's pending license application.

Separately, KBMY-KMCY, LLC will seek dismissal of the STA Extension Request, which is now moot.
