

Please let the XM Radio and Sirius Satellite radio merger go through. This is a very valuable service to me, but one that will drop in value if they cannot make profits. They rely on extremely expensive capital investments that are redundant when they compete against each other, but that become less expensive if they jointly compete against my mp3 player, AT&T audio-to-cell service or NPR on FM radio. I'd rather they competed against the free services so that I can get cheaper receivers and subscription rates. If their prices went up, I'd go back to FM-based NPR and my music collection. That competition, for me ear time, is well preserved if the merger is allowed.
