Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 3, 2007, Sean Belanger of CSDVRS and Karen Peltz Strauss of CSD met with Jay Keithley, Diane Mason, and Lynne Montgomery of the FCC's Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau to discuss proposals for a rate methodology for video relay services (VRS). It was proposed that the FCC consider a tiered approach that would set the VRS rate for three years and would recognize the cost efficiencies achieved by providers that handle greater volumes of calls. During the meeting, CSDVRS also discussed the extent to which outreach and marketing should be pulled from the per minute rate and divided equally among all providers, so that all providers, large and small, have an equal opportunity to provide outreach and marketing to the user community. CSD will soon submit a more thorough analysis of the tiered approach that was proposed during this meeting.
