On April 4, 2007, Shant S. Hovnanian, Chairman and CEO of Speedus Corp. and Managing Member of NetfreeUS, LLC, (“NetfreeUS”) along with legal counsel Stephen Coran and Jonathan Allen of Rini Coran, PC, met with Peter Daronco and Kevin Holmes of the Commission’s Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and discussed the above-referenced application filed March 2, 2007.

The participants discussed the public interest benefits of NetfreeUS’s proposal for a free, coordinated broadband service to promote entrepreneurial investment and localism. In addition, the parties compared the NetfreeUS and the M2Z Networks, Inc. (“M2Z”) proposals in these dockets, including discussions of premium services, throughput speeds and equipment requirements. NetfreeUS also inquired about the status of a Request for Confidential Treatment apparently filed with the Commission on March 26, 2007 by M2Z, which has not been made available for public inspection in ECFS or served on NetfreeUS.
