As indicated in the attached submission, Boeing has withdrawn its pending commercial earth station onboard vessels ("ESV") application. Accordingly, Boeing withdraws its Petition for Partial Reconsideration filed in this proceeding, which addressed technical issues associated with the operation of Boeing's proprietary ESV terminal.¹
