On April 20, 2007 I spoke separately by telephone with Daniel Gonzalez, Chief of Staff to Chairman Martin, Ian Dillner, Legal Advisor to Chairman Martin, Tom Navin, Chief, Wireline Competition Bureau, and Scott Deutchman, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Copps, regarding the above-listed proceedings. I explained the urgent need for Commission action on the Independent Panel's recommendations and the continuation of AT&T's special temporary authority for disaster planning¹ to allow for uninterrupted disaster recovery planning in advance of the start of the 2007 hurricane season.
