On April 23, SpectrumCo LLC (“SpectrumCo”) representative Dr. Coleman Bazelon had two separate telephone discussions with Evan Kwerel, Office of Strategic Planning & Policy Analysis, and with Wireless Telecommunications Bureau staff member Wayne Leighton, regarding Dr. Bazelon’s economic analysis (filed in this docket on April 20) responding to a Peter Cramton study filed by Verizon Wireless on April 17. In addition, on April 23, I had two very brief telephone conferences with Bruce Gottlieb, legal advisor to Commissioner Copps, and with Angela Giancarlo, legal advisor to Commissioner McDowell, on the same topic.

In addition, during these telephone calls SpectrumCo’s representatives voiced its support for the principles endorsed by the Balanced Consensus Plan supporters in their letter of April 18, noting that these principles will ensure that the 700 MHz license structure will better parallel the FCC’s successful AWS auction and allow greater bidder participation and flexibility.
