This letter is to report permitted, oral *ex parte* communications of Frontline Wireless, LLC (“Frontline”) and its counsel concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

On April 23, 2007, Janice Obuchowski (Chairman of Frontline), Gerard Waldron and Jonathan D. Blake met with Aaron Goldberger, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate. In a separate meeting on the same day, Ms. Obuchowski, Mr. Waldron and Mr. Blake met with Catherine Bohigian, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning & Policy Analysis. In the meetings, the parties discussed Frontline’s Public Safety Deployment Plan and service rules that would allow the FCC to implement this Plan by relying on existing Commission authority and without delaying the 700 MHz spectrum auction. The parties also discussed the Commission’s Designated Entity (“DE”) rules and emphasized the fact that Frontline’s proposal to require the “E” Block licensee to be a wholesale provider is consistent with these rules.
