Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 29, 2007, News Corporation (“News Corp.”), the DIRECTV Group, Inc. (“DTV”) and Liberty Media Corporation (“Liberty Media”) filed applications with the FCC seeking the FCC’s consent to the transfer of *de facto* control of DTV from News Corp. to Liberty Media. See File No. SAT-T/C-20070129-00021; MB Docket No. 07-18 (“Consolidated Application”). Pursuant to Section 1.65 of the FCC’s Rules, this is to inform the FCC that Liberty Media has completed the transaction with CBS Corporation (“CBS”) described in Liberty Media’s February 16, 2007 letter in this docket.

On February 12, 2007, Liberty Media and CBS entered into a share exchange agreement whereby Liberty Media agreed to exchange its shares of CBS common stock for the shares of a subsidiary of CBS holding CBS’ ownership interest in television station WFRV-TV in the Green Bay-Appleton, Wisconsin, designated market-area (“DMA”) and its satellite station WJMN-TV in the Marquette, Michigan, DMA, and cash. Liberty Media and CBS filed an application on February 12, 2007 seeking the FCC’s consent to the transfer of control of the CBS subsidiary, and of the WFRV-TV and WJMN-TV broadcast licenses, to LMC BET Holdings, LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Liberty Media. See BTCCT-20070212BBC; BTCCT-20070212BBD. The transfer application was unopposed and the FCC’s Media Bureau granted the application on April 6, 2007. The FCC’s International Bureau and Wireless Telecommunications Bureau also consented to the assignment of certain transmit/receive earth

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
station and wireless licenses in connection with this transaction. See SES-ASG-20070213-00232; ULS File No. 0002914077.

Liberty Media and CBS completed this transaction on April 16, 2007. As a result of this transaction, an indirect, wholly-owned subsidiary of Liberty Media (WFRV and WJMN Television Station Inc.) now holds the broadcast, broadcast auxiliary, transmit/receive earth station and wireless licenses associated with WFRV-TV and WJMN-TV. In addition, Liberty Media no longer holds the non-attributable ownership interest in CBS reported on page 10 of the Consolidated Application.

Finally, as set forth in its February 16, 2007 letter in this proceeding, because the transaction with CBS has resulted in a *de minimis* level of vertical integration with WFRV-TV and WJMN-TV, Liberty Media proposes to adopt each of the broadcast-related conditions imposed on News Corp. in the *News Corp. Order* with respect to those stations.
