

CAROLINA WEST WIRELESS, INC.

E911 REPORT

May 1, 2007

The following information is submitted in accordance with FCC directive:

1. The number and status of Phase II requests from Public Safety Answering Points

Seven PSAPs are located within Carolina West Wireless' service area. All have requested Phase II services. Carolina West Wireless is delivering Phase II data, and it is being processed by all seven PSAPs.

2. The dates on which Phase II service has been implemented or will be available to PSAPs served by Carolina West Wireless' wireless network

Phase II service is currently available to all PSAPs served by the network.

3. The status of coordination efforts with PSAPs for alternative 95% handset penetration dates

Greg Roark, Network Supervisor for Carolina West Wireless, has worked with the PSAPs to keep them informed of the carrier's location-capable handset penetration rates. He has informed them that Carolina West Wireless has reached the 95% benchmark.

4. Efforts to encourage customers to upgrade to location-capable handsets

Carolina West Wireless conducts campaigns advertising the safety and coverage advantages of the CDMA system and making special offers to encourage adoption of new handsets. In its last report Carolina West Wireless described a direct contact campaign to convert customers using TDMA and Analog service to E911 location-capable CDMA handsets. The campaign included customer notification that Carolina West Wireless would be phasing out the technology they were currently using and the offering of free phones to customers using the E911 noncompliant handsets. Business subscribers with TDMA and analog phones were visited by Carolina West Wireless sales and customer service representatives to assist them with handset transition.

5. The percentage of customers with location-capable phones

Approximately 97.6% of Carolina West Wireless's subscribers are using Phase II location-capable handsets.

6. Status in achieving compliance and whether Carolina West Wireless is on schedule to meet its revised 12/31/06 deadline

Carolina West Wireless met the goal of a 95% rate of penetration for location capable handsets on December 12, 2006, when a rate of 95.3% was measured. Carolina West maintains its policy of selling and activating only location-capable digital handsets. It continues to augment its CDMA network facilities and to conduct marketing campaigns to encourage consumer adoption of new handsets.
