On Wednesday, May 2, 2007, Gerard Salemme and Terri Natoli of Clearwire Corporation ("Clearwire") met with Fred Campbell, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau to discuss Clearwire's current operations. During the meeting, they touched briefly on certain issues in the above-referenced proceedings. Specifically, Clearwire expressed its view that rural areas and public safety would be best served through a 700 MHz band plan that is optimized for broadband services, includes spectrum blocks sufficient to enable TDD broadband deployments using WiMax equipment that is or will be commercially available in the near term and smaller licensed geographic service areas. In addition, Clearwire inquired about the status of the pending transfer of control applications of AT&T's 2.5 GHz spectrum licenses.
