On May 3, 2007, Time Warner representatives Steven Teplitz, Susan Mort and I met with Christi Shewman, Jeremy Miller and Jonathan Reel of the Wireless Competition Bureau's Competition Policy Division to discuss the referenced Petitions for Rulemaking.

During the meeting, Time Warner's representatives discussed the two referenced petitions for rulemaking, including the White Paper filed by Time Warner Telecom, Inc. regarding pole attachment rates. Specifically, Time Warner noted the importance of the Commission's prior decision to permit cable operators to attach drop wires to utility poles prior to any specific permit issued by the pole owner to do so and the practices of pole owners regarding surveys, makeready and construction requirements. Time Warner also cautioned against doing harm to a system that is working adequately on a case-by-case basis.
