
Re: Notification of *Ex Parte* Communications

This letter is to report a permitted, oral *ex parte* communication of Frontline Wireless, LLC (“Frontline”) concerning the above-referenced proceedings. On May 2, 2007, Ram Shriram with Sheralo Ventures, John Doerr and Ray Lane with Kleiner Perkins Caufield and Byers, both early investors in Frontline, and Lezlee Westine, CEO of TechNET, met with Chairman Martin, his Chief of Staff, Dan Gonzalez, and Catherine Bohigian, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning & Policy Analysis. The parties discussed Frontline’s Public Safety Deployment Plan and spectrum and service rules that would allow the FCC to address a number of important policy issues concerning competition and innovation in the broadband market.
