

**INITIAL RESPONSE OF HAMMOND BROADCASTING, INC.
TO REQUEST FOR SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION**

On March 30, 2007, the Commission released a "Request for Supplemental Information" in the above-captioned proceeding ("Request"), inviting comments on or before April 30, 2007. Hammond Broadcasting, Inc. ("Hammond"), by its attorneys and pursuant to Sections 1.87, 73.415 and 73.420 of the Commission's rules, herewith submits this initial response to the Commission's request, and states as follows:

Hammond is the licensee of FM Broadcast Station WIOK, Channel 298A, Falmouth, Kentucky. L.M. Communications of Kentucky proposes that, in order to enable allow it to upgrade its WBTF(FM) at Midway, Kentucky, from Class A to Class C3 (and essentially to better serve the Lexington, Kentucky, market), the WIOK frequency should be changed to Channel 300A.

Hammond showed that a WIOK operation on Channel 300A would create an unacceptable risk of interference on an FAA localizer frequency into Cincinnati/Northern

Kentucky International Airport. For this reason, *the* WIOK transmitter site is unsuitable for operation with Channel 300.

The Commission agrees that the FAA interference issue raises a site suitability question, *Request* at ¶ 7, and requests that the parties submit additional documentation, "such as a determination from the FAA, to establish whether Channel 300A is available at the licensed Station WIOK(FM) site." *Id.*


Hammond is pleased to respond. On April 5, 2007, Hammond filed a Notice of Proposed Construction (FAA Form 7460-1) with the FAA, in which the operation of WIOK on Channel 300A was proposed for study. See the attached summary for Air Study No. 2007-ASO-1579-OE, According to the FAA Obstruction Evaluation web site, the proposal has not yet been studied.

Hammond will apprise the Commission of further developments in the FAA Air Study.




